We deal with surveys and plans, appraisals, relocations and legal issues in the acquisition of right of way. Although we are not content experts in these areas we do have a good handle on the subjects.

The IPDC has established a specialty task force to compile and review information related to the specialty certifications and make recommendations to IPDC and IGC. ILPAC has assigned Jeff Jones as our representative and given Jeff recommendations to be discussed at the specialty task force meetings specific to specialty career paths and management credentialing.
