- 1. What is your Committee working on and how may the leadership within Region 1 be of assistance to you?**
 - Coordinating Region responses to 30 Contact Campaign
 - Preparing for 2012 Annual Conference
 - IRWA Vendor Participation in APWA Annual Conference

- 2. Has your Committee begun identifying sessions for the 2012 Annual Education Conference and are you working with other Region 1 Representatives to conduct co-sessions? If yes, with whom and which Committee(s)?**
 - ILPA is working on 5 sessions for the 2012 Annual Conference: Eminent Domain, Mediation, Pipeline Acquisitions, Design Build w/ Risk Management and CDBG Funding in Cedar Rapids.
 - ILPA is coordinating with the Transportation Committee (Jerry Colburn) to possibly co-sponsor a session, but no details have been work out to date.
 - No other Region 1 Representatives have been contacted for sessions.

- 3. Are there any current educational or professional business opportunities that affect your Committee's focus that would be of interest or benefit to the Region 1 membership?**
 - Changes to the SR/WA and credentialing requirements impact the ILPA's professional development.
 - The ILPA comments and develops course work for the implementation of the SR/WA and credentialing requirements.

- 4. What is the process for Region 1 members to be considered for Members-At-Large on the Committee you represent? Is there a waiting list or application process?**
 - A Member-At-Large needs to express interest in becoming a Member-At-Large to the ILPA Chair. The ILPA Chair then accepts them onto the Committee as Members-At-Large.
